FIZZ //

PROSECCO, DOC

//125ml £6 // BTL £24

A classic Prosecco with aromas of white peach, pear and flowers. The palate is fresh, not too dry, and clean as a whistle all the way through to the sparkling finish.

WOODCHESTER VALLEY BRUT 2018

SPARKLING ROSÉ, ENGLAND

//125ml £9 // BTL £36

Made with 100% Pinot Noir grapes grown in the Cotswolds. This dry sparkling rosé has luscious strawberry and raspberry aromas.

DRAPPIER CARTE D'OR CHAMPAGNE NV, FRANCE

//125ml £9 // BTL £40

The Carte d'Or cuvée is the very expression of the Drappier style. It opens with aromas of stone fruits such as white peach and has an element of spice that leads to a powerful and complex palate.

DUNLEAVY EXTRA BRUT 2018 SPARKLING RED, SOMERSET

// BTL £40

Using Pinot Noir and Rondo grapes, this fizz forgoes any dosage and sulphite is kept to a minimum. This is an ideal example of playful sparkling reds. The wine is light and juicy with notes of strawberry.

DUNLEAVY BRUT 2018 SPARKLING WHITE, SOMERSET

// BTL £45

Made from 100% Seyval Blanc, the grapes have been handpicked and pressed in Somerset then aged on the lees for 11 months to create something truly special. Deliciously fresh and fruity with a delicate fizz.

BLACK CHALK 2016 HAMPSHIRE, ENGLAND // BTL £60

After 8 years making over 120 different English sparkling wines in Hampshire, Black Chalk is the personal project of award winning winemaker Jacob Leadley and his family. Wild ferment, with maceration for 23 days. Six months oak ageing in third use barrels.

DRAPPIER BRUT NATURE CHAMPAGNE NV, FRANCE // BTL £60

A Blanc de Noirs of compelling purity, this Champagne is elegant and bone dry with delicate mineral and lemon notes filled out by richer flavours of pear and white peach.

DRAPPIER ROSE BRUT CHAMPAGNE NV, FRANCE // BTL £75

For one of Champagne's most forward-thinking producers, Drappier has no shortage of historic roots. Pretty red berry aromas lead to a delicate palate of summer fruit and herbs, finishing crisply dry and refreshing.

BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE CHAMPAGNE NV, FRANCE // BTL £80

Bollinger is one of the finest, non-vintage Champagnes available. It is rich, toasty and full bodied, with a wonderful concentration and depth of flavour.

DOM PERIGNON 2010 // BTL £195

Dom Pérignon is the prestige wine of Champagne house Moët & Chandon and a vintage is only released when the fruit is judged to be of the highest quality.

WHITE WINE // by the glass & bottle

2020 Pecorino,

Terre de Chieti, Italy 13% // 175ml £4.85 // BTL £18

Borgo Thaulero, Cool coastal breezes from the Adriatic give this wine layers of crisp, fresh fruits and delicate floral notes.

2019 Saint Chinian, Petit Paradis

Languedoc, France 12.5% // 175ML £5.20 // BTL £20

A blend of Marsanne, Grenache and Vermentino with some partial barrel fermentation. Complex with notes of quince, almond and spice.

Medium-full body with citrus zest and a waxy texture. A beautifully made and balanced wine.

2018 Culver hill, Woodchester Valley,

Cotswolds, England 12% // 175ml £5.75 // BTL £24

This delicious dry white wine is an intriguing blend of stone fruits with a delicate hint of minerality. A blend of Seyval Blanc, Ortega, Bacchus and Pinot Gris grapes.

2021 Allan Scott Estate, Sauvignon Blanc,

Marlborough, New Zealand 12.5% // 175ml £6.50 // BTL £27

Allan Scott is the Marlborough man. Among the first to plant Sauvignon Blanc in Marlborough, Allan Scott's vineyards are a stones throw away from Cloudy Bay and produce extremely high quality wines with help from his son Josh.

This wine is full of tropical passionfruit, lime and gooseberry flavours with a subtle herbal edge.

2020 Esencia Divina, Albarino

Rias Baixas, Spain 13% // 175ML £6.65 // BTL £28

Harvest is always done by hand and grapes go through two selection processes before maceration begins, ensuring that only the very best grapes are used.

Notes of white flowers, elderberry, mimosa, white fruits, apple and pear with a citrus background.

WHITE WINE // by the bottle

2017 Woodlands, Chardonnay,
Margaret River, Australia 13% // BTL £29

Fermented in barrel using 90% wild yeasts, just like a cru Burgundy, this wine has superb complexity and finesse with layers of ripe fruit, oak and freshness. Bright yellow colour with a smoky oak aroma over intense grapefruit and lemon.

2018 Orpheus Bacchus, Woodchester Valley,
Cotswolds, England 12% // BTL £29

The Orpheus is 100% Bacchus, selected from individual vineyard parcels and is the ultimate expression of the Bacchus grape. A wine of character, highly aromatic with intense elderflower and lychee fruits.

2019 Viognier, Ridgeback
Paarl, South Africa 13.5% // BTL £34

Intense, upfront notes of citrus blossom, glazed pineapple, white peach and lavender, a creamy midpalate is well supported by subtle oak with an elegant finish.

2018 Masi, Colbaraca Soave Classico,
Veneto, Italy 13% // BTL £37

Elegant nose of ripe pears and peaches with some floral notes. Fresh in the mouth, with some breadth and creaminess mid-palate.

2019 ZBO Zibbibo, Brash Higgins
Riverland, Australia 13.2% // BTL £42

Cloudy and a diaphanous, pale yellow in appearance. The wine is dry yet exudes tantalising herbal, spice and stone fruit aromas. Complex nose of apricot, graphite/pencil shavings, cut ginger, cloves, elderflower, white pepper, Belgian white ale, and wild honey leaps from the glass. On the palate, the wine has a soft entry but with good grip, an earthy sweet chalk/clay element with notes of lemon oil, tangerines, tea and cinnamon apples.

2018 Pesquera, Alejaren,
La Mancha, Spain 13.5% // BTL £49

Alejaren of El Vinculo, La Mancha, is a soft golden colour in the glass. The taste is sumptuous with rich flavours of ripe apricot, brioche, honeycomb, crème brûlée and soft white flower notes found both in the nose and on the palate.

2019 Domaine Mazilly, Les Meurgers Meursault,
Burgundy, France 13.5% // BTL £90

This Meursault from Mazilly is a rich and luxurious Burgundy. Well-balanced and structured in the mouth and beautiful golden yellow in colour with aromas of toasted nuts and ripe fruit. On the palate, there are wonderfully ripe orchard fruits notes supported by good, firm minerality. Dry and mellow with a lingering finish.

RED WINE // by the glass & bottle

2019 Domaine La Prade, Merlot,
Languedoc, France 14% // 175ml £4.95 // BTL £18

Situated in the foothills of the Pyrenees, near Carcassonne, in the unspoilt Aude region of the Languedoc Roussillon. A smooth, spicy Merlot with aromas of plums, berries and tobacco. The palate is medium-full and packed with both fruit and savoury flavours.

2020 Familia Gascon, Malbec,
Mendoza, Argentina 13.5% // 175ML £5.75 BTL £24

A fruit forward Malbec with aromas of fresh plums, blueberries and cherries. Its subtle contact with oak delivers notes of vanilla and cocoa.

2017 Conde Valdemar, Rioja Crianza,
Rioja, Spain 13.5% // 175ml £6.95 // BTL £29.50

Bodegas Valdemar is a family company whose roots date back to 1889, and whose Riojas have long been a reference point for the DO. Excellent, rounded structure on the palate with aromatic complexity lasting through to the finish.

2018 Thorn-Clarke, Shiraz,
Barossa, Australia 14.5% // 175ml £7.85 // BTL £32

This Barossa Shiraz has an intense red colour with vivid purple hues. The nose is abundant with vibrant red fruits supported by subtle hints of French Oak. On the palate, well balanced tannins are intertwined with flavours of black cherries, satsuma plums and mulberries. This all leads to a wine which is full bodied in style with a plush mouthfeel and great length of flavour.

2017 Norton Privada, Malbec Blend,
Lujan de Cuyo, Argentina 14.5% // 175ml £8.75 // BTL £34

Edmund Norton planted the first vines in Mendoza's Luján de Cuyo district. Privada is selected from vines between fifty and eighty years old, growing in vineyards at up to 1,100 metres above sea level. A rich chocolaty aroma leads to deeply spiced flavours of dark plum, kirsch and mocha.

2018 Scott Base, Pinot Noir,
Central Otago, New Zealand 13% // 175ml £8.95 // BTL £36

Allan Scott has long had an affinity with Central Otago. The Scott Base Vineyard was established in 1994 and is situated in the heart of Central Otago on terraces overlooking the town of Cromwell and Lake Dunston. The Scott Base Pinot Noir has aromatics of ripe cherries, raspberries and wild thyme. The palate is full of primary red fruits and finishes with smooth tannins and light oak sweetness.

RED WINE // by the bottle

2017 Tarima Hill, Monastrell Old Vines,
Alicante, Spain 15% // BTL £32

Produced by Tarima Hill, powerful, full bodied and deep with blackberry spice, liquorice fruit flavours and silky tannins from 80 year old dry grown bush vine Monastrell aged in French oak.

2018 Gerard Brisson Les Charmes, La Louve Morgon
Beaujolais, France 13.5% // BTL £34

La Louve, the original cuvée of Domaine Gérard Brisson. This wine, with its nose of red berries, develops fresh fruit aromas on the palate, drawing on the ripe fruits with the ageing.

2018 Pesquera Crianza, Tempranillo,
Ribera del Duero, Spain 14% // BTL £38

The Pesquera Crianza of Ribera del Duero has soft aromas of black fruits and sweet liquorice spice and hints of coca which edge around the more powerful fruit notes. A persistent finish and silky tannins highlight the quality wine making of this Crianza.

2012 Malbec Authentique,
Cahors, France 13% // BTL £40

From the spiritual home of Malbec, a superb expression of old vines Malbec matured in barrel for two years. Black cherry, fig & menthol aromas combine effortlessly with dark berry fruit flavours, fully ripe tannins and hints of mint & vanilla.

2018 Coyam, Organic Syrah Blend,
Colchagua Valley, Chile 14.5% // BTL £42

Coyam, Biodynamic Bordeaux style blend from the pioneering Emiliana winery in Colchagua. Dark & smokey with creamy spice & blackcurrant cassis, spice box aromas and flavours.

2018 Lethbridge, Shiraz,
Geelong, Australia 13.5% // BTL £45

Aromatic and finely etched, this Shiraz combines vivid scents of blackberry, pepper, elderberry and violets with a firm, muscular structure. An appetising dryness offsets the rich ripe fruit. Thrilling, dynamic Victoria Shiraz.

BIG REDS // by the bottle

2018 Gigondas, Domaine Grapillon D'Or,
Southern Rhône, France 15% // BTL £47

Gold medal winning Gigondas from Celine and Bernard Chauvet. A brilliant deep ruby red colour with intense aromas of red fruits, pepper, spice and liquorice. A full bodied and powerful wine, well balanced with a very long finish. Very rich and elegant, a must for Rhone fans.

2014 Chateau Bernadotte,
Bordeaux, France 13% //BTL £49

Bright black cherry and raspberry fruit on the nose with dried leaf and graphite notes lending complexity. This is well defined and displays good vigor. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannins, supple in the mouth with clean, fresh and minerally red fruit.

2018 Pulenta, VII Gran Corte,
Mendoza, Argentina 14.5% // BTL £65

Malbec blend with rich aromas of spice and cherry followed by full-bodied flavours of blackcurrant and mocha with a velvety, concentrated finish.

2016 Mt George Merlot,
California, USA 15% // BTL £82

Grapes for the Silverado Vineyards Mt. George Merlot are sourced from the western slopes of an ancient volcano located east of Napa in Coombsville. Aged for 16 months in a combination of French and Hungarian oak, this award winning Merlot displays aromas of ripe plum, black cherry, star anise and clove with a hint of cocoa and sweet oak on the finish.

2017 Bodegas Caro,
Mendoza, Argentina 13.5% // BTL £90

A collaboration between Nicolás Catena, whose family have been creating wines in Mendoza for three generations, and Domaines Barons de Rothschild, whose Château Lafite Rothschild is regarded as Bordeaux's "First Growth of First Growths" (Clive Coates MW). Matured in 60% new oak for 18 months, this powerful red is given structure and depth from premium Cabernet, while Malbec brings layers of supple red fruit.

2017 Vega Sicilia, Alion,
Ribera Del Duero, Spain 13.5% // BTL £120

From the famous producer Vega Sicilia, Alion is from the famed region of Ribera del Duero. 100% Tempranillo, hand harvested and aged in 100% new French oak barrels for 14-20 months. Deeply coloured, complex but still fleshy dark fruit, elegance being the hallmark of the Vega Sicilia vineyard.

RED WINE // magnums

2012 Conde Valdemar Rioja Reserva,
Rioja, Spain 14% // Magnum £75

The Conde Valdemar Rioja Reserva is an award winning example made from grapes sourced from the estates own vineyards in Rioja Alta and Rioja Alavesa. Deep, cherry color with ruby shades. Powerful and complex nose filled with aromas of ripe fruit and spicy notes dominating as well as licorice, truffle and cocoa touches. Displays a balanced palate, delicate and flavoursome. It has a silky entrance followed by a persistent finish with caressing tannins.

2014 Pesquera Crianza,
Ribera Del Duero, Spain 14.5% // Magnum £90

Soft aromas of black fruits, sweet liquorice spice and cocoa which edge around the more powerful fruit notes. On the palate the well balanced oak maturation is very well defined, complementing rather than overwhelming the fruit. 100% Tempranillo aged in new American oak barrels for 18 months and then a further 6 months in the bottle.

2015 Antinori Brunello di Montalcino,
Tuscany, Italy 14.5% // Magnum £170

Single estate wine from one of Italy's oldest wine families. Brunello di Montalcino is one of Italy's grandest wines, showing a complex, generous nose with ripe aromas of cherries and raspberries, light tobacco notes and hints of coffee and cocoa powder. Multi-layered structure with a nicely rounded texture and elegant fruit leading to a very long finish.

2020 Domaine Coste Rosé,

Languedoc, France 12.5% // 175ml £5.20 // BTL £24

Pale pink in colour, with a plump, dry palate and flavours of strawberry and blackberry. Fresh and round with good length.

2020 Dunleavy Pinot Noir Rosé,

Somerset, England 11.5% // BTL £26

Vibrant salmon colour; fresh red berries, floral nuance, light bodied. A lively and pretty wine with a mouthwatering finish.

Grown in a south facing, one-hectare plot in Chew Valley, North Somerset. Dunleavy have won 'Best Local Wine' at the Bristol Good Food Awards three years in a row. They have two bronze awards at the International Wine Challenge and 2 silver medals at UK Wine Awards & regional competition. The vineyard is owned and managed by Bristol resident Ingrid Bates who is one of the youngest vineyard owners in the country.

2020 Château Minuty et Or,

Côtes de Provence, France 12.5% // BTL £36 // Magnum £60

The Château Minuty Rose et Or is an award winning, vibrant and expressive style of rosé that combines zesty aromas with an intense freshness. This Côtes de Provence rosé is a blend of carefully selected, hand-picked Grenache and Tibouren grapes, made from only the free-run juice. Wonderfully pale in colour, the Rose et Or displays notes of citrus fruit and white flowers to the nose. The palate is complex with an exceptional freshness and finesse offering notes of pink grapefruit and white peach.
